Families, friends, residents and staff;

We are excited to announce all residents and staff tested negative for COVID this week, this means our residents can return to communal dining and group activities. We are working with our pharmacy to coordinate another booster clinic for residents and eligible staff. We will provide more information as we have it.

As the weather changes we are seeing an increase in visitors. Socialization and quality time is important and we strongly remind visitors to please take great precaution when visiting so we can reduce the risk of another COVID outbreak. Masks and face shields/goggles continue to be required while walking to the residents' room or when a staff member enters the room.

To assist in identifying our positivity rate and PPE requirements we have a visual display located near the elevator. We hope this will provide increased understanding of the PPE requirements.

As a reminder, visitations are allowed and we request you go directly to the resident's room to visit and please socially distance from other residents.

Do not visit if you have ANY cold of flu symptoms or experiencing any other illness.

- A mask must be worn that covers the nose and mouth while walking throughout the building
- A face shield must also be worn by visitors while walking to a resident's room
- Visitors may not associate with other residents during the visit
- Maintain social distancing from other individuals
- Do not visit if you had an encounter with a potentially positive or COVID positive individual within the last 14 days or if any new onset of illness exists.
